

Mail-In Ballot Voting Bylaw

The Mail-In Ballot Voting is now available to Crystal Lake voters. At the May 7, 2020 RM of Keys Council meeting, a new RM of Keys Election Bylaw was passed, including the option for a mail-in ballot voting system. This option will allow those eligible voters to participate fully in RM elections.

The next scheduled RM election is Monday, November 9, 2020. For those voters from Crystal Lake, the election this year will be for the Reeve position. It is important to know that you do not have to be a permanent resident of Crystal Lake, or even Saskatchewan, to be eligible to vote in RM elections.

Eligible voters must be:

- 1) A Canadian citizen
- 2) At least 18 years of age
- 3) And any one of:
 - a. A landowner (registered on the title) within the rural municipality
 - b. The spouse of a registered landowner
 - c. A resident within the rural municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately prior to the election

To participate in the mail-in ballot option, voters must go to the RM Office (located at 203, Main St, Canora) with government-issued picture identification and complete the required documents to register for the mail-in ballot. This registration can be completed anytime now and must be done prior to the date of the Advance Poll (November 4). Please call the RM office (306-563-5331) to ensure the Administrator is present, especially during the vacation season.
