



Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

(Do Not Drink Notice)

This Advisory applies to residents and users of Crystal Lake's water distribution system, and is effective Immediately, Wednesday May 19, 2021.

This Do Not Drink Notice is issued due to the water exceeding provincial guidelines for arsenic.

As arsenic is present in the drinking water supply, the Water Security Agency and the RM of Keys are advising all consumers to **NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING UNTIL FUTURE NOTICE.**

Consumers should do the following:

Do Not Drink Your Tap Water – Use Only Bottled Water. Bottled water or other source of known good quality water should be used for all drinking (including baby formula and juice), brushing teeth, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation.

Do Not Try and Treat the Water Yourself. Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting the water stand will not make the water safe.

Potable water is available at the following location: Golf Crystal Lake.

This Advisory is effective on the date and time listed above and will not be lifted until the water supply is determined to be completely safe.
